5. Krakow Dance Festival Immersion

3 – 9 August 2025

Nowa Huta Cultural Centre (NCK), al. Jana Pawła II 232

On the stages of the NCK and in Łąki Nowohuckie (meadows of Nowa Huta), artists from six European countries will present the most interesting phenomena in contemporary choreography brought together under the common theme of Immersion. It is therefore worth immersing yourself in this space of movement and gesture, especially as most of the performances will be shown in Poland for the first time. In the German-Swedish production *Unearth*, the audience will surrender to blissful introspection together with the dancers, and they will decide for themselves how long they want to watch the performance. The Irish "Dances Like a Bomb" explores the phenomena of youth and ageing, while the Greek show "Borborygmi" surprisingly explores the beneficial power of noise as a source of joy, solidarity and a sense of community. With the Czech performance *Microworlds*, aimed primarily at families with children 4+, we will discover that the earth is full of microcosms. The Polish scene will be represented by the "for 38 trillion voices plus one" *Inner Monologue* about illness and how man depends on bacteria, as well as *Love Letter*, a performance for one viewer revolving around the themes of love, desire and imagination, and the open-air *Snail's Footprint* combined with the premiere of the film.

The festival programme will be rounded off with movement, writing and creative workshops for seniors, a photography exhibition and a silent disco to end the whole event.

Musica Divina 2025: ERO CRAS

5 – 9 August 2025

Advent in August? Yes – and right in the heart of Krakow. This year's Musica Divina festival will be a story of hope and expectation. This is all to remind us that music – like true liturgy – transcends our here and now.

The motto of this year's festival: ERO CRAS ("I will come tomorrow") refers to the Advent Great "O" Antiphons and leads us towards one of the most powerful liturgical periods in terms of meaning. Inspired by the tradition of the Wawel Rorantists, the organisers boldly draw on this tradition.

It is a brave experiment, but not without foundation. For we have an extraordinary Advent site in Krakow, and right in the heart of the city: one of the most beautiful chapels in Wawel Cathedral, founded by King Sigismund I. Not only is it a pearl of Renaissance architecture, but for centuries it was also a place of everyday musical life thanks to the exceptionally intensive activities of the Rorantist Ensemble. Their duties included the daily singing at the Rorate Mass and at major church feasts.

Four personalities, four sensibilities and four ways of expressing themselves in art – Męskie Granie Orchestra 2025 is a true artistic melting pot. 26th Krakow Opera Summer Festival

The Royal Castle in Niepołomice

Opera goes outdoors – this is the festival's tagline, with which the Lubicz Street stage welcomes the arrival of summer. The culmination of its 26th edition will be performances in the Wawel arcade courtyard, which will see as many as three opera heroines strolling around the castle hill: Tosca, Aida and – naturally! – Queen Bona Sforza, the heroine of one of the Krakow Opera's latest productions, a work by Zygmunt Krauze to a libretto by Vincenzo de Vivo, which debuted on stage last November. Amidst the greenery will be a concert performed as part of the Krakow Opera's 70th anniversary *Operetta in the Garden, or Where Love Lives*. The most beloved melodies from operettas and musicals (including *Revenge of the Bat*, *The Merry Widow*, *The Czardas Princess*, *My Fair Lady* and *Fiddler on the Roof*) will be presented on stage in the Botanical Garden by guests including: Krystyna Tyburowska, Bożena Zawiślak-Dolny and Andrzej Biegun, as well as soloists, the OK Choir, Orchestra and Ballet.

In July and August, opera performances will take place in the most beautiful corners of Małopolska, including the castles in Nowy Wiśnicz and Niepołomice and Krynica Zdrój.

49th International Folk Art Fair

8-24 August 2025

Main Market Square

Colourful stalls filled with handicrafts from various regions of Poland and Europe and a stage under the Town Hall tower for three weeks resounding with performances by visitors from different parts of the continent, including Poland, Slovakia, Hungary, Ukraine, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Bulgaria, Lithuania and Latvia – the event on the Main Market Square, which is approaching its 50th anniversary, is not slowing down. We are in for a real journey through the richness of the cultures of Central and Eastern Europe and the Carpathian region, showing the variety of traditions, sounds and costumes that have been part of the character of the Fair for years. This year's programme features a variety of performers: from traditional song and dance ensembles, through bands presenting urban folklore, to modern ensembles interpreting folk music in interesting, contemporary and even surprising ways.

An extensive Workshop Zone is also planned, where people of all ages will be able to take part in handicraft activities (including lace-making, pottery, embroidery, woodcarving, weaving, paper-cutting, jewellery making inspired by folk design), as well as music and dance led by fair exhibitors and artists performing on the festival stage. The series of expert debates initiated last year, *Handmade in Krakow*, will also be continued at the Potocki Palace, this time devoted to the condition of the handicraft and crafts heritage in the exhibition and commercial space of contemporary Krakow.

Chełmoński

8 August - 30 November 2025

National Museum in Krakow, Main Building, al. 3 Maja 1

The Krakow exhibition crowns a monumental series of three monographic exhibitions of Józef Chełmoński (1849-1914). The two previous stagings took place at the National Museum in Warsaw and the National Museum in Poznań. The exhibition includes a wide selection of oil paintings as well as watercolours and drawing works from many private collections and from museum collections, both national and international. The extraordinary talent of the creator of *Gossamer* and the sensual beauty of his works earned him the status of a national artist, one of the most outstanding representatives of Polish realism.

Chełmoński's works are worth admiring as outstanding examples of 19th-century realism and delight viewers with their painterly development. This work also opens up the contemporary viewer to a love of nature with all the richness of the world of fauna and flora, reminding us of the need to care for the condition of nature and the necessity of coexisting harmoniously with it.

8th BNP Paribas Green Film Festival

11-17 August 2025

Vistula Boulevards

More than 50 films with an environmental theme – features and documentaries, long and short films – will compete at the **BNP Paribas Green Film Festival**. However, it is not the race for prizes that is most important here, but the popularisation of the environmental message among the widest possible audience.

This year, screens in several outdoor areas (on Czerwieński Boulevard, in front of the Krakow Gallery and on the Echo City Stage at ul. Kapelanka 56) will show, among others, *Documerica* (dir. Pierre-François Didek) on the state of the environment in the USA in the 1970s. *The Bloody Trophy* (dir. Ewa Galica) about a journalistic investigation into the illegal trade in rhino horns that leads to Poland, *Black Butterflies* (dir. David Baute) about three women from different parts of the world forced to migrate as a result of climate change, or *Even If the Flood After Us* about a brilliant physicist travelling back in time to prevent a thermonuclear reactor disaster. Another portion of films awaits at out-of-competition screenings, including a special children's zone. The reception of the individual productions will be deepened by discussions with experts in a friendly scientific stand-up format. As every year, the organisers will ensure that all events are prepared in a sustainable and socially responsible manner.

The Night of Cracovia Sacra 2025

14-15 August 2025

Church of Our Lady of Perpetual Help, os. Bohaterów Września 33

Thematic exhibitions, concerts, workshops, a city game and visits to museums and normally inaccessible nooks and crannies of churches and monasteries make up the rich and, as always, unique programme of this event. The dates are unchanged, the theme changes every year, which in this edition is: Royal Heritage in the Sacred Space. the 1000th anniversary of the Polish Crown.

Indeed, by the decision of the Honourary Committee for the Celebration of the Millennium of the Kingdom of Poland, this year's Krakow festival of sacred art was included in its entirety in the official calendar of the jubilee. The programme includes as many as fourteen concerts, including *Korona i Krzyż* (The Crown and the Cross) – a musical story of Queen Jadwiga, a spectacle of music, word and image by the artists of Piwnica Św. Norberta (14.08, 8.00 pm, the Carmelite Convent Na Piasku, ul. Karmelicka 19), *Jam jest Pasterz dobry* (I am the Good Shepherd) performed by the Scepus Baroque early music ensemble (14, 15.08, 7.00 pm, St John of God Diocesan Sanctuary, ul. Krakowska 48), and *Lectio Divina*, with the programme of the oldest preserved treasures and monuments of Polish music interpreted by the Octava ensemble (15.08, 7.00 pm, Abbey of the Benedictine Sisters in Staniątki, Staniątki 299). The Loch Camelot Theatre and the Auxilium Choir will present the premiere performance of "After a Pious Stay in the World., Eternal Life in Paradise" (15.08, 8.15 pm, Reformatius Church, ul. Reformacka 4). Nine thematic exhibitions will be on view, including in the hospital garden of the Fathers of St John of God, the Cistercian Abbey in Mogiła and in front of the basilicas of the Pauline and Franciscan Fathers. The programme of the Cracovia Sacra Night at the Benedictine Abbey in Tyniec is interesting. It consists of a thematic tour entitled "The Crown and the Monks, the Benedictines and Power" and a family workshop entitled "At the Origins of Poland". The Wawel Cathedral Museum will present unique parchment documents issued by Casimir the Jagiellonian and Sigismund the Old. The urban game "Crowns, infula and Krakow artefacts" will involve finding and learning about places with special references to Polish history, including in particular the 1000th anniversary of the coronation of Bolesław Chrobry as the first king of Poland. Admission to the events of the Cracovia Sacra Night is free, but tickets are required for some of them, so it is worth finding out about the programme in advance.

Tour of Fort Borek

Duration: approx. 90 minutes.



Gojira, the French masters of modern metal, are returning to Poland for one concert. They will perform on 19 August 2025 at Krakow's Tauron Arena.

This band needs no introduction to anyone ... Really: to anyone. After Gojira's phenomenal performance at the opening ceremony of the Paris Olympics, it is not only metal fans who know them. The whole world was stunned to hear and see them perform a brutal and heavy version of "Ah! Ça ira!".

We were not surprised, because we know very well what an excellent band this is. We know this thanks to the Frenchmen's sensational concert at Mystic Festival 2023 and thanks to the show they gave a few months earlier in Gliwice. We know this thanks to numerous previous visits to Poland – from the first ones, in tiny clubs, to the big stage of the Pol'And'Rock Festival. No matter where they performed and under what circumstances, they were always the kind of concerts that you remember for a lifetime.

Gojira is currently working on the follow-up to the critically and fan-acclaimed 2021 album Fortitude, promising something both more ambitious and heavier. "It's meant to be a step up and forward, so we're putting all our love and energy into this record," Joe Duplantier, the quartet's vocalist and guitarist, said recently.

Whether they are already coming with new material or as part of a break in a recording session – we will give them the welcome they deserve.

22nd Hubert Jerzy Wagner Memorial

29-31 August 2025

Tauron Arena, ul. Lema 7

The best volleyball friendly in the world will once again carry the fans in Krakow. TAURON Arena will host the Polish national team this year, as well as Serbia, Brazil and Argentina. The Krakow volleyball festival will be played from 29-31 August 2025.

This will be a unique event, in an important year for Polish sport. The 22nd Hubert Jerzy Wagner Memorial will be a general test for the red and white team ahead of the World Championships, which will be played in the Philippines from 12 September. The Polish national team will face Brazil, Serbia and Argentina at the TAURON Arena Krakow.

A year ago, the turnout for the three-day tournament was extremely impressive. On the final day of the tournament played in Krakow's TAURON Arena, we had a full house of 15 000 fans in the stands, Saturday's matches were watched live by more than 13 000 fans, and on Friday almost 10 000. The 22nd Wagner Memorial promises to be just as good in terms of attendance, and Polish fans are sure to fill the stands to capacity.

Accessible cinema in Wesoła

30 August 2025, at 8.30 pm

The Design Pharmacy, ul. Kopernika 19a

In the summer, the meadow on Wesoła will be transformed into a huge cinema hall. Surrounded by greenery in the very centre of Krakow, three films will be screened: the painterly tale of Vincent van Gogh, a dramatic story of love in post-war Europe and an uncompromising slice of contemporary Polish reality. The screenings will be preceded by lectures, and the whole event will be prepared with accessibility for all viewers in mind – without barriers.

At the last film event at Wesoła on 30 August, we will see Wojciech Smarzowski's *Kler*, a film that has moved public opinion and sparked a wide debate about the institution of the Catholic Church in Poland. Three clergymen, who share a common past, struggle with their own weaknesses, internal conflicts and systemic abuses. The director does not spare the viewer from difficult questions and does not give simple answers – this is a film that forces you to think. Prior to the screening, Dagmara Romanowska will give a talk in which she will discuss the social issues raised in the film, the way in which Smarzowski presents them and the reactions the production provoked in Poland and abroad.
